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Bosky perfume but with a touch of jewelled and (still) oh-so bright cranberry fruit. The fruit has a lustrous glow, like looking at a ruby through firelight. All the wood has melted into the fruit. Little smudges of truffle and mace. It tastes like a rain-soaked red maple leaf pressed into the winter-cold terracotta tile of a very old roof. The flavours diffuse through your mouth, like walking through soft mist in autumnal woods with your tongue out. A lesson in ageing these wines...? (TC)
