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Sour cherry and cherry stone, dark cocoa powder and earthiness – like the smell and taste of a mushroom just picked off tree roots, still mossy, not cleaned, fresh, otherworldly. But then there is the sharp, clean spice of Barbera fruit that brings us back from otherworldliness to a wine that will be delicious with a simple roast-tomato chilli pasta. (TC)
